By signing this agreement, you agree to the policies below and realize that there will be physical activities involved in doing this show. Please remember that your participation in this show is greatly appreciated. The success of our show is dependent upon all involved and your executive staff, fellow cast and crew members rely on your cooperation, reliability and promptness.

PLEASE BE THOROUGH IN YOUR PLANNING. Conflicts that arise after casting may result in members being removed from a role or a number.

STUDENTS & PARENTS

- 1. Junior Thespian Productions (JTP) promotes a Christ-Centered Code of Ethics** which include courtesy and kindness, integrity and character, self-control and humility, generosity of spirit and respect.
- 2. Junior Thespian Productions is entirely self-supporting with funding from participation fees, advertising, costume fees, ticket sales and donations.** Financial obligations must be paid at registration in order for the success of the production. By signing this contract, agreement has been made to uphold these important policies, regulations and principals.
- 3. REHEARSALS WILL END PROMPTLY.** Please respect the time and schedules of JTP employees and pick up your student on time. It is not safe to ask your student to wait in the parking lot after rehearsal has ended.
- 4. SCHOOL REQUIREMENTS:** Students must maintain a good grade point average in order to participate in the show. Students participating in any JTP production are bound by the policies of their individual schools. In particular, please pay special attention to the Sexual Harassment policy* – appropriate behavior must be exhibited at all times.

Harassment Policy:

JTP is committed to providing an environment that is free from harassment in any form. Harassment of any person by any other persons is strictly prohibited. We will treat any allegations of harassment seriously and will review and investigate such allegations in a prompt, confidential, and thorough manner. A charge of harassment shall not, in and of itself, create the presumption of wrong doing. However, substantiated acts of harassment will result in disciplinary action, up to and including removal from the show. Anyone found to have filed false and frivolous charges will also be subject to disciplinary action, up to and including removal from the show. Harassment includes, but is not limited to, any or all of the following: **Verbal Harassment** and **Physical Harassment**.
